The European Genomic Data Infrastructure (GDI) project is enabling access to genomic and related phenotypic and clinical data across Europe by establishing a federated, sustainable and secure infrastructure to access the data.

The project builds on the outputs of the Beyond 1 Million Genomes (B1MG) project and is realising the ambition of the 1+Million Genomes (1+MG) initiative.

Outcomes of the first GDI Stakeholder Forum

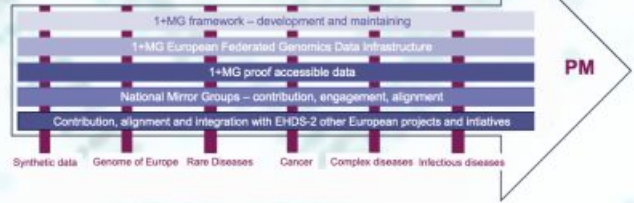
The first annual GDI Stakeholder Forum was held on 23 November 2023. The Forum focused on the role of industry in building an ecosystem of genomic data sharing for patient benefit.

The primary aim of this stakeholder forum was to disseminate key project information, updates, and outcomes to participating stakeholders. Additionally, current gaps and challenges faced by the GDI project were addressed, and potential corresponding solutions, including the role of industry, were discussed comprehensively.

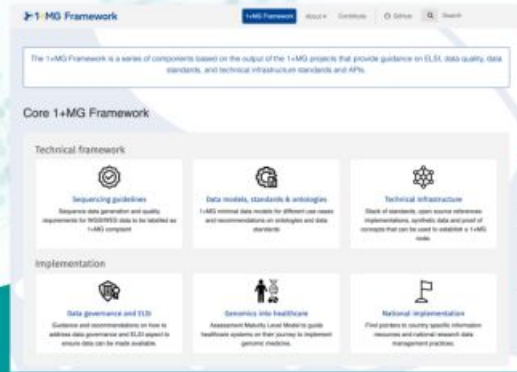
The event was attended by a total of 113 participants and there was great discussion in the breakout sessions. Initial conclusions from this meeting included: the importance of increased awareness of the work conducted by industry, especially on transparency around the use and analysis of data, to gain and improve public trust; collaboration with industry stakeholders for innovation and sustainability of infrastructure and tools is key; the need for a robust legal framework for the secondary use of data.

1+MG Framework and Roadmap launch - paving the way to providing secure access to genomics and health data across Europe

On 14 November 2023, the [1+ Million Genomes \(1+MG\) Initiative](#) launched the 1+MG Framework website and adopted the 1+MG Roadmap 2023-27, which together pave the way for implementing genomics for personalised healthcare and research in Europe. The 1+MG Framework organises the recommendations, guidelines and best practices of European Union (EU) experts to realise the initiative's ambition for secure access to genomics and health data across Europe. The 1+MG Roadmap 2023-27 provides detailed plans of how to get there and will be regularly updated.
